#### Camp Nou

Camp Nou is a football stadium in Barcelona, Spain. It is the largest stadium in Europe and the tenth largest in the world. Many international matches are played there. There is a museum in the stadium—the FC Barcelona Museum. It is considered the best football museum in the world. #### **Beijing National Stadium**

Beijing National Stadium, also called the Bird's Nest, is located in China. It was designed for use during the 2008 Summer Olympics and Paralympics. It is the world's largest steel structure(钢结构). The stadium has recently been transformed(改造) so that it can be used for winter sports.

#### Maracana Stadium

Maracana Stadium is an open-air stadium in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil. It was opened in 1950 for the FIFA World Cup. Since then, it has mainly been used for football matches between the major football clubs in Rio de Janeiro. It is the largest stadium in South America.

### **Wembley Stadium**



Wembley Stadium is located in Wembley Park in London, England. The England national football team play most of their home matches there. The stadium is also used for other sporting events. It is the second largest stadium in Europe (after Camp Nou) and one of the largest and the tallest in the world, with every seat under a roof. It was very expensive to build.

A study tries to find out whether taking notes by hand helps you learn better than taking notes on a laptop. Scientists from Princeton University carried out experiments on 327 students. All students got the same lectures, but some used laptops, and others took notes by hand.

When it came to learning the concepts(概念), the handwriters won. When it came to recalling facts, the groups were almost the same, except when given time to go home and look at their notes, at which point the handwriters did better.

"Even when allowed to review notes after a week's delay, laptop users performed worse on tests of both factual content and conceptual understanding," the study states.

Learning suffered not because students using laptops cannot focus their mind. In the lab, scientists allowed no extra activities. Students who paid attention and took deep notes on their laptops still didn't learn as well. In fact, the study shows the *thoroughness* of their notes causes the problem. Laptop users took notes word by word mindlessly, but handwriters wrote fewer words. By selecting the more important information, handwriters studied more efficiently, said researchers. The study suggests that writing is better and the hand has a "unique relationship with the brain when it comes to organizing thoughts and ideas."

Here's what's a bit frightening: When the laptop students were asked to cut down the long notes, they couldn't. The chance of persuading students to put away their laptops is probably zero. Many of them can't write longhand(速记), a forgotten subject in many American schools.

So should we come back to traditional classrooms if we want the brightest students? Perhaps not: Another possibility, some have suggested, is apps that permit handwriting on tablets, which students might accept.

Zhang Tian graduated from university and got a teacher's certificate last year. He wanted to start a new lifestyle. He had met wonderful teachers from small villages during his early school years and he was inspired by *them* to go and teach where he was needed the most. For that reason he applied for and became a volunteer teacher in a village school. Bringing with him lots of books, clothes, and two pairs of trainers, Zhang Tian travelled to the village with an <u>eager</u> heart. He imagined all sorts of exciting things about living independently and teaching in a village.

However, not everything lived up to Zhang Tian's hopes. The school was much smaller than he had expected, with only three classrooms. In front of the classrooms, there was a playground which got dusty on windy days and muddy on rainy days. Living in the village was also more **challenging** than he had thought. The power and water supplies were unstable, so he could only shower every three or four days, and he had to learn how to cook. The thought of leaving once flashed through his mind, but he quickly gave up on the idea and found ways to deal with the challenges.

The school had just three teachers and Zhang Tian was the only English teacher. The other two local teachers were **responsible** for maths and Chinese. To make school life healthier and livelier for his students, Zhang Tian introduced more subjects to the school—music, art and PE. It is not surprising that PE is the kids' favorite subject! Their school lives are now more attractive and interesting, and they enjoy playing football in the playground, as well as singing songs they've learnt.

Zhang Tian's first year is almost over. It has been a tough year, but he has enjoyed working with the children. What made him feel satisfied was that his students were able to read, speak and write in English, and they became more **confident** in learning. The village is like his second home now. Although he had

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only intended to stay for one year, he now feels ready to stay for another year. He feels so happy that he followed his heart when choosing what to do with his life, even though it may not be what others expected of him.
